## Lesson Six Christian Vocabulary

One of the things that can be confusing to a new Christian is the unique vocabulary that Christians use in conversation or in church services. A glossary of some of these words has been prepared to help you become acquainted with them.

It will be helpful at this point in your lessons to take the time to study the meaning of these words. As you learn the meaning of words you will also be learning about various Christian beliefs.

## The Method for this Lesson

We suggest that you use the following steps in the study of this lesson:

- 1. Start at the beginning of the glossary and take one word at a time.
- Read the definition and think about its meaning until you think you understand it.
- Write a sentence using the word on the line provided below the definition.
- 4. Look up at least one of the references given to see how the word is used in the Bible. Try to understand the truth that it expresses.
- 5. Mark the words that are still confusing to you so you can talk about it later with the person who is teaching you.
- This lesson may take several sessions to complete. Go as far as
  you can in the allotted time for each session, and then continue in
  the next session until you have covered all the words in the
  glossary. Feel free to take as many sessions as you need to
  complete this lesson.
- 7. Write on the lines below any words that you hear or see in print that you do not understand and cannot find in the glossary. You may ask your teacher later to explain what they mean. Then you can write the meaning after the word to keep for future reference.
